ABOUT NURSING:

Nurses play a key role in keeping people healthy. They may assess patients who are ill or injured and help doctors treat them. Or they may provide information about nutrition and exercise. Nurses combine a passion for medicine and caring for others in their jobs every day.

Core Tasks:

- Perform physical exams
- Collect patient information
- Provide medical treatments e.g., bandaging wounds
- Administer medication
- Monitor results of treatments
- Keep patients informed
- Maintain record and charts

- About 194,500 opening for registered nurses are projected each year, over average, over the decade.


