Some sessions have limited spaces available. We encourage you and your child to review the available clubs and sign up promptly to secure a spot in their preferred activities. Please understand that while we will do our best to accommodate as many students

as possible, certain clubs have a maximum capacity. Miss Tatton will email your child with their confirmed choice.

For this half term, registration opens on Monday 18th September, with a deadline of Friday 22nd September and the activities will start from week beginning 25th September.
