### How to interpret Pastoral data: Attendance

Your child's attendance percentage falls into one of 7 category bands from band A to band G. Each band indicates the level of support needed or recognition given.

Percentage	Category	Band
97-100%	Excellent	A
95-96.9%	Acceptable	B
93-94.9%	Below Expected	C
90-92.9%	At risk	D
80-89.9%	Support	E
51-79.9%	Intervention	F
Under 51%	Severely Absent	G

Your child's attendance, achievement and behaviour totals are reported as "Year to date", with the year group averages also provided.
