The Ugandans have been: Today, we had another joyous time with The AYF Band (also known as 'The Ugandans') who brought their usual uplifting music, singing and dancing. They have been an annual inspiration to us for many years. To support their work back in Uganda we will also be fundraising for them.



Christmas themed non-uniform day: This coming Thursday (12th December) is our 'Christmas themed non-uniform day' to help raise money for the Ugandan orphanage.

Students fondly remember the visits from The AYF Band from Uganda. Some members of that band run an orphanage in Uganda and we would like to send our support and love back to them with a financial gift that would help them continue their selfless work.

1. Through your child's Scopay account under the *Tips and Events* tab, or your child can hand in cash. This needs to be done by Monday 9th December.
2. If you want to pay in cash, your child must have handed in their money by Wednesday 11th December

If you would like to donate more than £2, that is fine – ***all*** the money is going directly to the orphanage.

In order that we can hopefully maximise the gift to the orphanage, we would politely ask that you do not feel compelled to buy any new clothes for this day in school.
