How to interpret current attainment (this is not your child's data in the example below)

Your child's current working grade has been colour coded to demonstrate performance against their Lowton target in each subject.

GREEN	<i>The current working grade is above, equal to or one grade below the target grade.</i>
ORANGE	<i>The current working grade is two grades below the target grade.</i>
RED	<i>The current working grade is three or more grades below the target grade.</i>

Your child's current grades have been fine graded.

High (H)	<i>Top end of the grade.</i>
Secure (S)	<i>Middle of the grade.</i>
Low (L)	<i>Bottom end of the grade.</i>

How to interpret Pastoral data: Attendance and Behaviour

Your child's attendance percentage falls into one of 7 category bands from band A to band G. Each band indicates the level of support needed or recognition given.

Percentage	Category	Band
97-100%	Excellent	A
95-96.9%	Acceptable	B
93-94.9%	Below Expected	C
90-92.9%	At risk	D
80-89.9%	Support	E
51-79.9%	Intervention	F
Under 51%	Severely Absent	G
