Year 11 GCSE Results Day Arrangements: Thursday 21st August 2025

I hope this letter finds you well and that the summer provides some rest and relaxation.

Thursday 21st August is the national date set for students to receive their GCSE results. We want this to be a special day for students after their hard work.

We will be issuing results for *GCSEs from 9am to 11am in J block.*

Students will be able to access this area from the school car park. ***After 11am results can be collected from B Block Reception until 1pm on Thursday 21st August.*** Senior leaders, teachers and support staff will be available to students immediately after the publication of results, so that results may be discussed.

We are looking forward to students collecting their results in person on results day.

Results can only be issued to the student directly, or to a representative with the student's permission. If your child is unable to collect their results on the day and they need to send a representative to collect their results, *they must complete the consent form attached to this letter and return it to school.*

We will not be able to issue exam results to anybody other than your child unless they have completed and returned their consent form.
