How to interpret attainment data

Your child has been placed in one of five current attainment bands based upon their performance. The bands indicate a likely GCSE grade at the end of their GCSE course.

Band	E	D	C	B	A

When comparing your child's current performance against their target band, one of three indicators have been allocated. Please see the example below.

- (+) This means your child is currently working above their target band.
- (=) This means your child is currently working at their target band.
- (-) This means your child is currently working below their target band.

How to interpret pastoral data

Your child's attendance percentage falls into one of 7 category bands from band A to band G. Each band indicates the level of support needed or recognition given.

Percentage	Category	Band
97-100%	Excellent	A
95-96.9%	Acceptable	B
93-94.9%	Below Expected	C
90-92.9%	At risk	D
80-89.9%	Support	E
51-79.9%	Intervention	F
Under 51%	Severely Absent	G
