
## Lowton Church of England High School.

We hope that this guide will help you during the first few weeks at school. Remember it is normal for new Year 7 pupils to feel a bit nervous about moving to high school but staff will do their best to help you find your way around and get settled into a new school and routine.

When you arrive at school you come in through the Year 7 gate. A teacher will be there to welcome you and to remind you to switch off your phone.



You will see the Year 7 toilets on your right after you go through the gates. A teacher will be just outside the toilets at breaks and lunchtimes.





Next to the Year 7 toilets you will see the door to the Year 7 canteen. A teacher will be there to supervise the queue.



Inside the canteen you can buy drinks such as milkshakes and juice and buy snacks such as toast and bagels at break, and pizza, burgers, pasta, chicken wraps or curry at lunchtime.

There will be teacher in the room to talk to if you need any help.

After the next gate is the Year 7 area where you can hang out with your friends at break and lunch times. This space is for Year 7 only. Each year group spends social time in their own zone.





This is H Block. This block is in the Year 7 zone and contains all of the Year 7 form rooms.





The picture above shows the door to H4. Mrs K Roberts who is the Head of Year 7 often works in here during break and lunchtime. If you need to speak to her there is a good chance you will find her here.







This is the Hub and it can be found in F block. Teaching Assistants are here at break and lunch times to support you with homework and offer a listening ear. You can also come here to the Hub between 8.00 and 8.30 before school for homework support.



This is the entrance to Student
Support Services and it can be
found next to the gym. If you are
unwell, are upset or have been
injured you can come here for
help. You can also buy equipment
like a pen here.
