How to interpret the pastoral data: attendance and behaviour.

Attendance percentages, behaviour and achievement points have been reported up to the week beginning 12/7/21. This information may be different than within the form tutor comments, as tutors wrote the comments prior to the final data extraction. The year group average enables you to compare your child's attendance against their peers, whilst the ranking indicates a placement within the year group from 1 to 100 with 1 being high. COVID-19 related absence has not been counted against your child.

How to interpret the "meeting school expectations" judgements.

Y - means that your child's quality of homework, participation in lessons and behaviour is at the acceptable school standard.

N - means that your child's quality of homework, participation in lessons and behaviour is **not** of an acceptable standard. There are concerns that we may like to discuss.

How to interpret the current working grade.

Green means that your child is working above, working at, or working one grade below their target grade.

Orange means that your child is working 2 grades below their target grade.

Red means that your child is working 3 or more grades below their target grade.
