It has been a challenging week for us and many schools in dealing with a number of positive COVID cases and having to ask 'bubbles' to isolate. Thank you for your understanding and support when we have to respond to these situations very rapidly. Further down this letter you will see information relating to changes from September.

Non uniform day fundraising (Friday 16 July).

Next Friday, we are asking all students and staff to participate in a non-uniform day to raise money for Wigan and Leigh Hospice. The hospice has supported many families within our local and school community. They are currently running at a loss of £2,192 a day and we would like to show our support for the immensely important work they do to care for people in our local community.

We are asking students who would like to participate to donate a minimum of £2 each. This can be done online using Scopay. The deadline for <u>online</u> payments is Wednesday 14th July. If students are handing cash in they need to do so via their form tutor. The deadline for <u>cash</u> is Thursday 16th July.

Year groups will be holding other activities during the day on Friday so you may wish to send your child to school with some extra change to participate in these events. Thank you in advance for your support.

Changes to dealing with COVID-19 from September.

You will have heard some significant changes announced this week by the Prime Minister and the Education Secretary.

From September contacts of a positive case will no longer be required to isolate. This does not affect our arrangements up to the end of this summer term. This means that from September if there is a positive case in school we will no longer have to complete contact tracing in school and we will no longer be sending 'bubbles' home if your child was a close contact of a positive case. Any child with symptoms would still book a PCR test as they should now.

Twice weekly lateral flow testing will continue until the end of September in the first instance and will then be reviewed by the Government.

In school, a number of the procedures we brought in to support our own safety during the pandemic have worked well to set the right culture and behaviour expectations and so we will continue with them in school. For instance, we will continue with:

- Specified year group zones.
- Split lunch times.
- Specified canteens for year groups.
- Handwashing at the start and end of the day.
- Hand sanitisation at the start of lessons.
- Line ups outside before the start of lessons.
- Years 7 and 8 will come through the car park entrance
- Years 9, 10 and 11 will come through the main gate on Newton Road.

Students are expected to wear a mask in lessons until the end of this term, but from September, face coverings will no longer be a requirement. This will be kept under review at a local (Wigan) and national level.

From September, there will no longer be a staggered end to the day. The school day will end at 2.50pm for all students.

Start of autumn term (September 2021) arrangements and testing.

To start the new school year we will be required to test all students twice in the first few days where we have consent. The Government allows us to stagger the start of term to ensure this testing can be done and so we will do the following:

We will be holding two-day special induction for our new Year7s (those currently finishing primary school) on Tuesday 31 August and Wednesday 1 September.

Summer holidays testing and reporting test outcomes.

Over the summer period, please continue to complete lateral flow tests on Sundays and Wednesdays. You will not need to report your test results to school but you should continue to report them to the NHS.

Thank you for your continue understanding and support through all that we have collectively had to cope with.
