Covid Update



Lateral Flow Testing

The school will be offering lateral flow tests to students on their first day of school and 3-5 days later. We strongly encourage all students to participate in the testing programme.

Please complete the lateral flow testing consent form that is enclosed with this booklet. Your child MUST bring the form with them on their first day if they wish to be tested.

Year 7s

We appreciate that performing a lateral flow test may worry some of our new students. We will explain the process to students and show them a video to help prepare them for the test.

Covid Safe Routines

- Students will remain in their year group zones in order to minimise contact with others.
- Students will line up outside their teaching blocks to avoid mixing in corridors.
- We will ensure that rooms are ventilated.
- Students will not be required to wear masks.
- We will continue to sanitise hands at the start and the end of lessons.
- If a student tests positive for Covid, then he or she will be required to isolate. We will not send close contacts home.

Acceptable shoes are:


Plain all black shoes without a logo

Transport

Transport to and from school

- We strongly encourage students to walk or cycle to school.
- Bicycles must be locked in the Cycle Bay at the student entrance. Students who wish to cycle to school need to complete a registration form that is printed on the next page.
- Parents must not drive on to school site to drop off their children unless they have been given permission as part of their personal learning plan.

How can parents help?

- 1) Please avoid dropping in at reception unless it is urgent. We will <u>not</u> be able to hold unplanned meetings.
- 2) All meetings with parents will be via phone or video call unless there is a specific need that requires a face-to-face meeting.
- 3) Use email, where possible, to communicate with staff.
- 4) Ensure that you have downloaded the Parent App and Satchel One App to give you up to date information about your child's learning and progress in school.
- 5) Please be polite to staff at all times. We expect courtesy and good manners in our interactions with parents.



Cycling to school
