Frequency:

- All other subjects will set 1 quiz on Satchel One each week and 2 written pieces each half term, except art which will set 2 drawing/design pieces each half term.
- Students will be trained re how to use Satchel One. This will happen in their computing lessons in the first week of term. **Homework will commence from Monday 13th September.**
