How to interpret the Engagement information

Level	Evidence
H (High)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils have completed all, or nearly all the work set by their teacher. • Pupils will only have missed one or two pieces of work set by their teacher. • Pupils can demonstrate engagement across a wide range of learning opportunities. • Pupils have demonstrated a sustained and appropriate level of effort for the work set by their teacher.
M (Medium)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils have completed most of the work set by their teacher. • Pupils can demonstrate engagement across a range of learning opportunities. • Pupils have demonstrated an appropriate level of effort for the work set by their teacher.
L (Low)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils have completed very little of the work set by their teacher. • Pupils have decided to complete a certain type of work and omit others. (for example, quizzes have been completed but sustained pieces of written work have not been attempted.) • Pupils have demonstrated a limited level of effort for the work set by their teacher.
M (Minimal)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There has been no engagement for any of the work set by their teacher.
