Your child has been placed in a one of five target attainment bands. **The attainment band relates to your child's GCSE Lowton Target Grade for the end of Year 11.** Your child's teachers have made a Yes or No judgement as to whether your child is meeting their target band expectations.

Y = means that your child is meeting their attainment band expectations.

N= means that your child is not meeting their attainment band expectations.
