Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you regarding **End of Year Examinations in Year 9**. On Tuesday 7th May the year group will have a special assembly which will give key information about these examinations. The key points are as follows:

Exam Period

Formal end of year examinations start on Friday 24th May and end on Friday 28th June. The main body of exams will take place in a 3 week period which commences on Monday 3rd June. All students will sit examinations in each of their GCSE subjects. All students will be issued with a timetable so they know exactly when each examination is taking place.

Examinations

All examinations will take place in classrooms apart from English, R.S. and Mathematics. These examinations will take place in the sports hall. This is to ensure that students can start to be prepared for the experience of sitting a formal examination as there are lots of rules and regulations surrounding this which students need to get used to.

Revision

All students will be issued with a booklet which tells them exactly what they need to revise and what revision materials to use.

What does your child need to do now

Students need to start revision now to prepare for these exams in 3 weeks' time. In form time, tutors will go over the exam timetable and students will be asked to record the dates in their planners.

Copies of the examination timetables will also be posted on our school website.
